News from F1...

We have had our first full week in F1 and the children have been amazing! The children have enjoyed listening to the story 'The Colour Monster' and telling us about what makes them feel happy, sad, cross and scared. It has been great fun seeing the children's different facial expressions to represent how the Colour Monster is feeling! We have continued to talk to the children about their feelings whilst they have been busy choosing what colour to collage and paint their own Colour Monster. We had our first PF session this week in the hall and the children had fun playing some games. Well done F1!







News from F2...

What a fantastic and busy week we've had! As well as continuing to embed our routines, we've begun our daily phonics sessions this week, which the children have loved! We've all been really impressed by how well they have started on their Read, Write Inc journey. In maths we have been subitising to 3 and practising our counting skills. Our key text this week is The Colour Monster and we've had lots of fun creating our own colour monsters using paint, crayons and collage and talking about the different feelings. Great work F2!

News from Year 1...

Year One have settled into their first full week with ease, we are very proud of them!

This week the children have been retelling traditional and fairy tale stories using small world provision, story maps and roll a story maps. The children have explored the vocabulary often found in fairy tales and been using this in their own spoken and written sentences.

In Maths the children have been counting out an amount from a larger group and representing it in a variety of ways, including using the 10 frames, they have also been learning how to read numbers in their written form and this is something you could certainly practice with them at home please. We have also sorted shapes and items into two groups and discussed the many ways they could be sorted. In Computing we have used the BEE BOTS and programmed them to follow directions on a map.







News from Year 2...





This week, in English we have been describing the fearless pirates using adjectives. In Science, we have explored living and non-living things. Did you know that to be a 'living thing' it has to: breathe, move, grow and need food and water to survive? In maths, we have focused on using base ten to learn all about place value. Ask us to identify how many tens and ones are in a number.

We are excellent at it!
